- 2. Wear comfortable clothes and shoes so you can dance. For safety reasons no bare feet area allowed on the stage.
- 3. You may be asked to sing one of the attached excerpts at a call back audition. It would be good for you to familiarize yourself with the following songs:

Chorus: "Six Months of Every Year" m. 189 – 212 and "Heart" m. 4 - 11 Lola: "Whatever Lola Wants" m. 3 – 10 Meg & Joe Boyd: "A Man Doesn't Know" Applegate: "Those Were the Good Old Days" m. 50 – end

#### **Smart Auditioning Tips:**

- 1. Do your homework! Listen to the CD and read about the show. Find info on the internet!
- Practice the excerpts! The dialect is tough you will need to look at the readings ahead of time because some of the words are unfamiliar.
- 3. Be honest about your conflicts if you are interested in being cast, then you must make this show a priority in your schedule.
- 4. Have your application completed ahead of time and include your \$35.00 activity fee, made payable to MHS. (Refunds will be given if you cannot be in the show).
